



Shinny Participant Information and Guidelines

Shinny is a first come first serve drop-in program offered at Gateway Ice Centre.

- A maximum of 30 participants will be allowed on the ice – not including goalies.
- A maximum of 4 goalies will be allowed.
- Adult shinny is 2 hours in length.
- Youth shinny is 1.5 hours in length.
- Cost of participating is based on the day of the week and time of day.
- Payment methods accepted: Cash, Debit, Visa, and MasterCard.
- Selling of admission will begin 30 minutes prior to the start time at the front desk. At this time you will receive a wrist band which must be visible while on the ice.
- Goalies play for free only if they are participating in the shinny program and MUST sign in at the front desk and wear the assigned wrist band.
- Participants must play within their age category.
- Pucks, shirts, equipment, etc is not provided for any shinny program.
- A skate monitor will be provided for Youth shinny.

Skate monitors may or may not go on the ice depending on the number of participants and parents requests. The skate monitor will be in the designated rink if they are not on the ice surface. The skate monitor is provided only to supervise participants to ensure they are following the “laws of the game” and do not provide coaching/training.

Rules

- Full hockey equipment is required including a CSA approved hockey helmet.
- The hockey “laws of the game” are to be followed; referees are not provided but skate monitors will supervisor youth shinny.
- Players must wait until the Zamboni is off the ice before going on the ice.
- All participants must be fair to one another and allow everyone equal playing time.
- Individuals displaying unacceptable behaviour or who chose not to follow the rules will be asked to leave. This includes the following violations:
 - Dangerous Play – body checking, slashing, tripping, etc
 - Fighting
 - Abusive and/or Obscene Language or Behaviour
 - Horseplay
 - Vandalism or Damage to the facility

Gateway has a strict “No Alcohol and/or Smoking” Policy and participants caught in violation will be asked to leave. Gateway Ice Centre is not responsible for lost and/or stolen articles.
